INFORMATION HANDOUT

DATE OF EXAM : 25.04.2010

1. This booklet contains details pertaining to various aspects of the examination you are going to take and important instructions about related matters. **The assessment of answersheets will be done by a computerised machine, hence you should carefully read instructions regarding handling of the answersheet and the method of marking answers.** You are advised to study this booklet carefully as it will help you in preparing yourself for the examination.
2. Before appearing for the written examination you should strictly ensure yourself that you fulfil the eligibility criteria in all respects. The organisation will reject, at any stage, any candidate who does not satisfy the eligibility criteria.
3. Please note that since this is a competitive examination, mere passing is not adequate. You have to obtain a high rank in the order of merit. You should, therefore, put in your best efforts in the examination.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Particulars to be Noted** : Please note carefully your Roll Number, date, time and venue for the examination given in the call letter. Please also note that this call letter does not constitute an offer of employment. No travelling allowance or other expenses in connection with the examination will be paid.
2. **Punctuality in Attendance** : You should be present at the examination hall at the time given in the call letter. Candidates arriving late will not be permitted to enter the Examination Hall.
3. **Call letter to be Surrendered** : The call letter should be brought, when you arrive at the venue for the examination along with a copy of a recent passport size photograph of yourself, firmly affixed in the space provided for it in the call letter. You will be required to sign in the space provided for candidate's signature on your call letter in the presence of the invigilator in the examination hall. If you come to the examination hall without the call letter or without the photograph affixed on it, you will not be permitted to appear for the examination. You should hand over your call letter to the invigilator in the examination hall, when he collects the call letters from the candidates.
4. **Compliance with Instructions** : You should scrupulously follow the instructions given by test administrators and the invigilators at the examination venue at all the stages of the examination for which you have been called. If you violate the instructions you will be disqualified and may also be asked to leave the examination hall.
5. **Use of Books, Notes and Copying or Receiving/Giving Assistance Not Allowed** : No calculator, separate or with watch, books, note-books or written notes will be allowed inside the examination hall. Any candidate who is found either copying or receiving or giving assistance will be disqualified.
6. **Sample Answersheet and How to Fill in Information On it** : A sample answersheet is attached to this booklet. Fill in the required biodata and other information on this answersheet for your practice and bring it with you to the examination hall. You will get a similar answersheet in the examination hall, on which you will have to copy the biodata and other information already filled in by you. How to fill in the information on the answersheet is explained on page 2.
7. **Use of HB Pencil and Ball Pen** : You are required to fill in the information on the answersheet which you will get in the examination hall, by HB pencil and ball-point pen. You are required to mark your answers by the HB pencil. Therefore, you should bring with you **two HB pencils, a good quality eraser, a sharpener and a ball-point pen.** You are advised to bring two pencils to avoid mending a pencil during the examination as you may lose time. Use ball-point pen for filling up the information in boxes 1-5 & 8-11. Use HB pencil only, for filling up information in boxes 13, 14, 17, 20 and 29. **All the answers on side 2 also should be marked by using HB pencil only.**

You will NOT fill in any information in the boxes 6, 7, 15, 16, 18, 19 and 21-28 of the answersheet.

8. **Handling Answersheet** : Please handle your Answersheet with extreme care and keep it dust-free. If it is mutilated, torn, folded, wrinkled or rolled, it may not be assessed. Answersheets and question papers will be supplied by the organisation. After the test is over, you should hand over the same to the invigilator before leaving the room. Any candidate who does not return the question booklet and/or answersheet or is found to attempt to take or pass on the question booklet or answersheet inside or outside the examination hall will be disqualified and the organisation may take further action against him as per rules.
9. **Rough work to be done on the Booklet** : You are advised to do all the necessary rough work on test booklet/question paper itself only. You **SHOULD NOT** do your rough work on the answersheet or any other paper. If any rough work is done on the answersheet, your answersheet will not be assessed.
10. **One Single Answersheet** : For all objective tests there will be a single answersheet.
11. **Method of Showing Answers** : All your answers must be marked on the answersheet only. The method of indicating answers as described and illustrated must be followed. If this is not done the answersheet will not be assessed by the computerised machine.
12. **Write Roll No. on the Test Booklet** : You should write your Roll No. in the space provided on the cover page of the test booklet. If you do not write your Roll No. on the test booklet your answersheet will not be assessed.
13. **Information on the Answersheet** : You should write all the information required on the answersheet such as Roll No., Name, Test Form No., etc. If you do not write your Roll No., Name and Test Form No. etc. your answersheet will not be assessed.

HOW TO FILL IN INFORMATION ON THE ANSWERSHEET

Important :- (1) The information is to be filled only in boxes 1-5, 8-11, 13, 14, 17, 20 on side 1 and in box 29 on side 2 of the answersheet.

(2) You have to fill in information in **boxes 1-5 and 8-11** by using **ball point pen**.

(3) Information in **boxes 13, 14, 17, 20 and 29** is to be filled in by using **HB pencil only**.

(4) On side 2 answers to the questions are to be indicated by HB Pencil.

Full Name of the Candidate (Box No. 1) : You have to write your full name in **capitals in English** as given in the call letter.

Other Information (Box Nos. 2 to 5) : You will find that the information asked for in these boxes can be filled in easily. Fill in this information by using ball-point pen.

(Box No. 6) : Keep this box blank.

Test Booklet Serial Number, Test Battery Number and Test Form Number (Information required in Boxes No. 8-10) : Test Booklet Serial Number, Test Battery Number and Test Form Number (information required in Boxes 8-10) are printed on the test booklet. You have to copy these numbers using **ball point pen** from the test booklet you will receive at the time of examination.

Candidate's Signature (Box No. 11) : You should sign in the space provided for it. Your signatures on the application, call letter and answersheet should be identical.

Candidate's Name (Box No. 13) : There is a row of 10 boxes for writing the name. Just below each box you will find a column of 26 ovals each containing a letter of the alphabet. The top oval in each contains a letter 'A' whereas the last oval bears 'Z'. Write your name in capitals by entering one letter in each box using HB pencil and blacken the appropriate oval under each box. If your name contains more letters write only the first letters which you can accommodate in the Boxes provided.

Candidate's Roll Number (Box No. 14) : You will be assigned an 8 digit Roll Number by the Organisation. There is a row of 8 boxes provided to write the Roll Number. Just below each box there are 10 ovals numbered from 1 to 9 and 0. You have to write your Roll Number in the boxes, entering one digit in each box by using HB pencil and blacken the appropriate oval under each box. You have to write your Roll Number on the test booklet also in the space provided for it.

(Box No. 15 & 16) : Keep this box blank.

Test Form No. (Box No. 17) : You will have to write the test form number (3 digits) under item 17. Write each of the digits in the boxes provided and blacken the appropriate ovals by HB Pencil.

Date of Birth (Box No. 20) : You have to enter the date, month and the year in the boxes and darken the appropriate ovals correctly. If the date or the month happens to be single digit you should indicate this after adding 'zero'. Darken appropriate oval in Box 28 also. Write your Roll No. in Box 29 on side 2.

THE WRITTEN EXAMINATION

I. The written examination will comprise objective type tests. The details of these tests are given below :

I. OBJECTIVE

All these tests would be in a composite test booklet. There will be a separate answersheet for indicating your answers. All these 175 questions would be printed serially from Q. No. 1 to Q. No. 175. You may attempt the Questions/Tests in any order you like. However, in your own interest you are advised not to spend too much time on any one test. To qualify in the written examination, it is necessary to pass in each one of the objective tests separately.

Given below are some sample questions for each of the tests. Study them carefully.

Please note that the types of questions for all the tests are only illustrative and not exhaustive. In the actual examination you will find questions of higher difficulty level on some or all of these types and also questions on the types not mentioned here.

Test I : Reasoning

This test measures how quickly and accurately you can think. This test has questions based on Verbal Reasoning.

Below are given some sample questions :

Q.1. Some leaders are dishonest. Satyapriya is a leader. Which of the following inferences definitely follows from these two statements ?

- (1) Satyapriya is honest (2) Satyapriya is dishonest
(3) Some leaders are honest (4) Leaders are generally dishonest
(5) Satyapriya is sometimes dishonest

Q.2. Four of the following five are alike in a certain way and so form a group. Which is the one that does not belong to the group ?

- (1) red (2) black (3) green (4) colour (5) yellow

Of the five, 'red', 'black', 'green' and 'yellow' are names of colours. 'colour' is not the name of a colour. Therefore, the answer is 'colour' which is answer No. (4).

Q.3. 'Foot' is related to 'Man' in the same way as 'Hoof' is related to _____

- (1) Horse (2) Dog (3) Shoe (4) Blacksmith (5) Saddle

The answer is 'Horse' which is answer No. (1).

Now try the following questions _____

Q.4. If the letters in the word TOPS can be rearranged to form a meaningful word beginning with O, write the last letter of that word, if more than one such word can be formed write M and if no such word can be formed write X.

- (1) T (2) P (3) S (4) M (5) X

Q.5. 'Day' is related to 'Night' in the same way as 'Kind' is related to _____

- (1) Dark (2) Bright (3) Cruel (4) Generous (5) Gratitude

Q.6-10. Below is given a passage followed by several inferences drawn from the facts stated in the passage. Examine each inference separately in the context of the passage and decide upon its degree of truth or falsity. Give answer (1) if you think the inference is definitely true i.e. it properly follows from the statement of facts given; give answer (2) if you think the inference is 'probably true' though not definitely true in the light of the facts given; give answer (3) if you think the data are inadequate i.e. from the facts given you cannot say whether the inference is likely to be true or false; give answer (4) if you think the inference is 'probably false' though not definitely false in the light of the facts given; give answer (5) if you think the inference is 'definitely false' i.e. it cannot possibly be drawn from the facts given or it contradicts the given facts.

Now read the following passage and the inferences given below it and mark your answers on the answersheet.

The caffeine in one's morning coffee or tea may improve the complex reasoning ability of extroverts but has the opposite effect on introverts. More than 700 people were given caffeine equal to no more than three cups of coffee and then tested on word analogies, sentence completion and identification of antonyms. The researchers believe that the caffeine was beneficial to the extroverts in the morning because they take longer to wake up. Introverts are more alert in the morning and become over stimulated by the drug that interferes with their reasoning power.

- Q.6.** Extroverts do not find caffeine beneficial in the evening.
- Q.7.** Caffeine affects reasoning ability of people who drink tea or coffee.
- Q.8.** Caffeine has greater effect early in the morning
- Q.9.** The adverse effect on the reasoning power of introverts is not due to caffeine.
- Q.10.** Complex reasoning ability is made up of word analogies, sentence completion and identification of antonyms.

Test II : English Language

This is a test to see how well you know English. In this test there may be passages with questions based on their content to test your comprehension. Your English language ability would be tested through questions on grammar, vocabulary, synonyms, antonyms, sentence completion, understanding of the contents of the passage, choice of appropriate words, phrases, expressions and similar language skills.

Q.11-13. Pick out the most appropriate word from amongst the words given below each sentence to complete it meaningfully.

- Q.11.** He quickly glanced the book to find what it said about Indian economy.
 (1) at (2) through (3) in (4) to (5) over

The correct answer is 'through' which is answer No. (2)

- Q.12.** The counsel urged the court to down the obnoxious law.
 (1) hit (2) beat (3) cancel (4) strike (5) declare

- Q.13.** The local official the Minister of the situation.
 (1) explained (2) warned (3) apprised (4) told (5) intimated

Q.14-15. Read each sentence given below to find out whether there is any grammatical or idiomatic error in it. The error, if any, will be in one part of the sentence. Do not look for errors in spelling or punctuation. When you find an error, mark the number of that part of the sentence as the answer on the separate answersheet. If there is no error, the answer is (5).

- Q.14.** I am twenty / two years old / when I first / joined the airline. No error
 (1) (2) (3) (4) (5)

The error is in (1). Therefore the answer is '1'.

- Q.15.** Of all the teachers / in our school, / our class teacher / were very strict. No error
 (1) (2) (3) (4) (5)

Test III : Quantitative Aptitude

This test helps to know how fast and accurate you can work with numeric calculations. In each question one number is missing. The place where the number is missing is shown by a question mark (?). Four answers are provided against each question. They are shown by numbers (1), (2), (3) and (4). You have to find out which one of the answers can replace the question mark. If none of these four can replace the question mark, the answer is (5).

- Q.16.** $42 + 73 + 137 = ?$
 (1) 352 (2) 252 (3) 242 (4) 142 (5) None of these

Q.17. $20 \times \frac{1}{2} = ?$

- (1) 4 (2) 5 (3) 12 (4) 20 (5) None of these

252 is the correct answer to Q. No. 16. So your answer would be (2). The correct answer to Q. No. 7 is 10. Neither 1, nor 2, nor 3, nor 4 shows this answer. Therefore your answer is (5).

Some of the problems may require arithmetical reasoning. For example :

Q.18. The interest on a certain deposit at 9% per annum is Rs.405 in one year. How much will be the additional interest in one year on the same deposit at 10% per annum ?

- (1) Rs. 40.50 (2) Rs. 450 (3) Rs. 855 (4) Rs.45 (5) None of these

Q.19. The breadth of a rectangular hall is three-fifth of its length. If the area of the hall is 135 sq.m. what is the difference between the length and breadth of the hall in metres ?

- (1) 3 (2) 6 (3) 9 (4) 15 (5) None of these

Q.20. If the profit made by selling a pen for Rs.10 is as much as its cost, what is the cost price of the pen ?

- (1) Nil (2) Rs. 5 (3) Rs.10 (4) Rs. 20 (5) None of these

HOW TO SHOW YOUR ANSWERS :

Each question is followed by answers which are numbered 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5. Select the most appropriate answer. Then by using HB Pencil, blacken the oval bearing the correct answer against the serial number of the question. Please note that the oval should be dark enough and should be filled in completely. For example, if the answer to Question Number 2 is answer number 5, it is shown as follows :

HOW TO CHANGE YOUR ANSWER :

If you wish to change your answer ERASE COMPLETELY the already darkened oval by using a good quality eraser and then blacken the new oval bearing your revised answer number.

While changing the answer, erasing the earlier answer completely is extremely essential. If it is not erased completely smudges will be left on the erased oval as shown below and the question will be read as having two answers and will be ignored for giving any credit.

Q.2. (1) (2) (3) (4) (5)

(Smudge left in oval No. 3 due to bad erasure, and the fresh answer in oval No. 4 will be read as two answers 3 and 4 and therefore no credit will be given even if the answer No. 4 happens to be the correct answer).

Now follow the correct method of showing your answer with HB Pencil and mark your answers to all the 20 questions given so far in this booklet on the portion of the answersheet given below. Answers to the first two questions have been marked.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER

1. You are advised to bring with you the following things : -
 - (i) Your system generated printout of the application with the application fee in the form of a demand draft and the requisite documents such as certificates pertaining to age, educational qualification, work experience etc.
 - (ii) Call letter with recent passport size photograph affixed on it.
 - (iii) Two HB Pencils, a ball point pen, a good quality eraser and a sharpener.
 - (iv) A valid proof of identity such as a PAN card / driving license / voter ID card / permanent identity card issued by the present employer or any other valid proof of identification with a photograph.
 - (v) The application fee in the form of Demand Draft of Rs. 400/-.
2. Write your roll number given in your call letter **ACCURATELY** on the answersheet and on the test booklet.
3. In the examination hall when the invigilator asks you to tear open the wrapper of the tests in the objective test booklet, open the same only along right hand edge. **DO NOT** remove the staples of the booklet which are at the left hand side. Immediately after opening the test along right hand edge, verify that all the pages containing questions in that test are properly printed and then begin answering the test. In case the booklet is defective get it replaced by another test booklet. Till the invigilator replaces your booklet continue answering other questions which are not defectively printed so that you do not lose time while answering the test.

 - (ii) use any method of marking your answers other than darkening the ovals.
 - (iii) do not write your Roll No. on the test booklet
 - (iv) do not write all the information required on the answersheet such as Roll No., Name, Test Form No., etc.
 - (v) do not handle your answersheet carefully
 - (vi) do not use HB Pencil where it is required
5. Do not resort to guessing. It is not likely to improve your score.
6. Before coming for the written examination, please ensure that you are eligible according to the eligibility criteria stipulated in the Advertisement/Notification. If you are not eligible, your candidature will be cancelled at any stage of the recruitment. Please note that even if you qualify in the written examination and subsequently it is found that you do not fulfill the eligibility criteria, your candidature will be cancelled.
